

CTE Sequencing

Completer= Student who achieves a C in BOTH a concentrator and capstone course in the same industry sector pathway

NOTE: Only seniors who have taken the concentrator course may be enrolled in the capstone, no push-in seniors with no prior pathway coursework

A capstone and concentrator course may NOT be taken at the same time/ same year

Capstone/ Advanced CTE Course
10th-12th graders with the **mandatory PREREQUISITE of a C or better in the concentrator** course in the same industry sector

2 years = 300 hour minimum & Must have both with C or better to qualify as a "Completer" in the same Industry Sector Pathway

9th-11th graders. This course is the prerequisite to the Capstone/ advanced course. Students who took the Intro course and achieved C or better should be prioritized. No Seniors can be enrolled in this course

Concentrator/ Intermediate CTE course **MANDATORY Prerequisite to Capstone Course.** Students should show interest in the sector, and plan to take two years (concentrator and capstone). Many of these concentrator courses are dual enrolled and rigorous/

Intro/ Exploratory CTE Courses (some pathways have 3 courses and it is recommended that students take all three for greater success)

Beginner, scaffolding for pathway success or introduction to industry/ pathway **9-12th graders**, although it is not recommended for Seniors.

NO SENIORS should be enrolled in this level course as they will not be able to become completers

- CPA's begin in 10th grade at WHS, contain 3 CTE courses and at minimum a concentrator and Capstone
